Submission Guideline

What can you send us?

Essays, short stories, interviews, etc.

The text must be no longer than 5000 characters (including spaces). All texts have to be submitted digitally in Microsoft Word (.doc) and must be written in english. If there are notes or quotations in the text, please follow the Harvard style. If you consider it necessary, you may attach a short bibliography.

Each text may be supported by a maximum of 3 images. Images should be sent in JPEG format. Each image must have name of photographer/artist, year and its source.

Indicate in the text the passage to which you would like the images to correspond (pic.01, pic.02, etc.).

Photographic projects, illustrations, drawings, projects...etc

A maximum of 5 images may be submitted. Images must be sent in JPEG format (300 ppi, 1920 x 1080 pixels). Each image must have name of photographer/artist and its source. Images must be supported by a descriptive text (maximum of 1000 characters, including spaces). The text must be submitted in Microsoft word format (.doc) and must be written in english.

Poems and thoughts

There is no length limit for texts. The text must be sent in Microsoft word format (.doc) and must be submitted in both the original language and english. The text, if you consider it necessary, may be supported by an image in JPEG format which must have name of photographer/artist and its source.

All contributions must have a compulsory title and an optional subtitle and, if you deem it necessary, may be divided into paragraphs to which you must give titles.

Remember to include your name (real name or artist's name).
